BIOGRAPHY

Curt Tomasevicz began the sport of bobsledding in 2004 and made an appearance in the 2006 Olympic Winter Games in Torino, two years after his debut as a bobsledder. He placed sixth in four-man in Torino, Italy, with driver Steven Holcomb. Tomasevicz was an alternate this season (2006-07) on World Cup tour for driver Steve Holcomb and won gold in Cesana, Italy. Tomasevicz earned his bachelor and master's of science degree in electrical engineering with a minor in astronomy from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. He was named an Academic All Big XII in 2002 and also played football for the Cornhuskers from 2000-03.
